

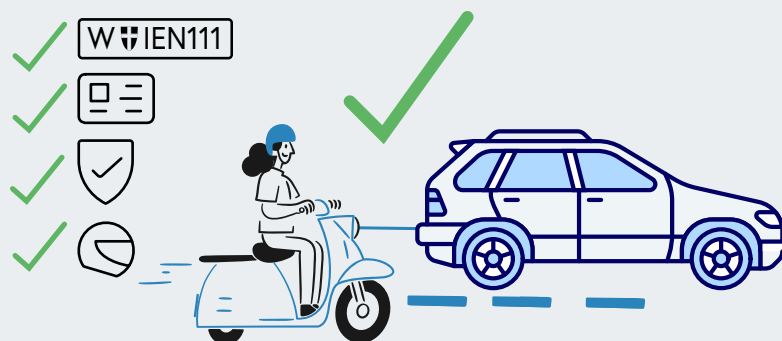
Attention: New rules for electric mopeds

From 1 October, e-mopeds will no longer be permitted to use cycle paths, cycle lanes or other cycling facilities. They are considered motor vehicles and must use the road.

Important change

Only when **all** requirements are met may e-mopeds continue to be used on public roads. From 1 October, e-mopeds may no longer be used without a number plate, driving licence and insurance.

instead of cycle paths

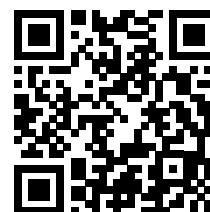


Compulsory helmet use
